

Trade Credit

Book No Further awards credit up to 20 percent of original publisher's price, based on condition, supply and demand. Book No Further makes all final decisions on which books are accepted and the credit awarded.

Using your credit

Trade credit may be used for up to 50 percent of the amount of your purchase

At least 50 percent of the price of used books must be paid in cash. The remaining balance will be taken from your trade credit. Used book trade credit may not be used towards purchase of audio books, new books, items marked cash only or special orders.

Book No Further tracks credit with an electronic inventory. Book No Further has final authority on awarded credit, transactions and tracking.

Store credit must be used at least once a year.

Example:

<u>Tax</u>	<u>\$1.33</u>
Total	\$ 26.33
50% of used books in credit	<u>-\$ 5.00</u>
Total amount due.	\$ 21.33

Your receipts will indicate your credit balances, which are final when you leave the store.

Credit remains active and available for 12 months from the customers most recent purchase. (i.e. Customers must make at least one purchase within 12 months or their last trade or the credit expires.)

Used-Book Trade-for-Credit Program

Trade your gently used books for credit toward other like-new books.

Book No Further accepts selected books in trade for credit toward the purchase of other used books.

We accept books based on condition, supply and demand: **Books must be**

- **In like-new condition**
- Without stickers, glue etc.
- No notes or highlighting; water damage, other stains; age discoloration.
- No smoke, mildew or other odors

Fiction: Current popular books and bestsellers.

Recent bestsellers now superseded by other titles (such as last year's John Grisham novel) or available in paperback receive less credit than the newer releases.

Non-fiction: More narrow-focused topics preferred along with advanced science and technical books

BNF may offer reduced credit value for books with a previous owner's inscriptions, book plates, blind stamps, or other "ex libris" marks; excessive edge wear; creases along the spine or other wear, usage or damage.

Submitting books for consideration

Book No further will accept one box or two tote bags of books on a walk-in basis. For **larger quantities** books (more than one box or two totes), contact the store in advance. Feel free to bring a sampling of large collections for consideration. Unaccepted books left in the store more than 30 days will be considered abandoned and appropriately discarded.

Preferred Books – in prime condition

- Like-new quality books
 - No stickers, glue etc.
 - No notes or highlighting; water damage, other stains; age discoloration.
 - No smoke, mildew or other odors
- Released in the past six months especially needed.
- Local (Western Virginia) authors or history or fiction set in the area
- On school reading lists, especially classics
- Children's books:
 - chapter, picture, nonfiction, fiction in **prime** condition
- Children's series books: Wimpy Kid, Dog Man, Smile, etc.
- Classic literature and non fiction
- Sci-fi, fantasy, horror
- For reluctant readers or teen boys
- Award winners, especially
 - Coretta Scott King Award
 - Costa Book Awards
 - Edgar Awards
 - Indie Booksellers' Choice Awards
 - John Newbery Medal
 - Man Booker Prize
 - National Book Awards
 - National Book Critics Circle Award
 - Nobel Prize-winning authors
 - Pulitzer Prize for Letters, Drama and Music
 - Randolph Caldecott Medal
- Chapter books: Clementine, Ivy & Bean, Dork Diaries and Graphic Novels, etc.
- Large-print books
- Mass market sci-fi, fantasy or classics in **prime** condition (no broken spines)
- Selected hardcovers fiction, nonfiction especially history and biography
- Trade paperbacks: fiction and nonfiction

Unacceptable for Trade

- Almanacs
- Cassettes audiobooks (CDs ok)
- Laminated books
- Dictionaries more than five years old
- Encyclopedias
- Ex-library books
- Games or puzzles
- Hardcover fiction that's out in paperback (with occasional exceptions)
- Hardcovers without dust jackets
- Harlequin Romances and other similar series
- Library discards
- Magazines
- Manuals
- Men's series action/adventure (i.e., Mack Bolan)
- Multi-volume sets (Time-Life, etc.)
- Reader's Digest and other condensed books
- Textbooks
- Time-Life series books
- Books that become dated quickly, such as computer manuals, travel guides, or diet, finance, and education books
- Rare or Antique books (We can direct you to sources for selling these)
